## GLIMPSE of India Satcom-2017

India Satcom 2017 was warmly welcomed by all - the Government, the Regulator, the country's central planning think tank, the industry, the academia, the market researchers as well as the media. The previous edition held in December 2017 was graced by Hon'ble Minister for Communications Shri Manoj Sinha, Shri RS Sharma, Chairman - TRAI (Regulator for Telecom, ICT & Satcom) besides Secretary-Telecom. The event also saw release of the Satcom White Paper by Hon'ble MOC Shri Manoj Sinha titled 'Satellite Broadband & Digital India'. The event was attended by over 100 Delegates, 22 speakers and was extensively covered by 30 persons from the media. The Media coverage extended to 10 Print, 53 Online & 1 Electronic outlet. The Hon'ble Minister even posted his inaugural address on his home page.

The event was sponsored by leading Satellite Players viz. Inmarsat, Hughes, Global Eagle, Intelsat, Asiasat, Viasat, Star TV & Nelco. Previous editions have included sponsorships from international companies like Kymeta, etc. The event was supported by Ministry of Communications, Ministry of Electronics & IT (Meity) & Niti Aayog

**As a logical outcome of the event, BIF made some key recommendations to the Govt of India that included:**

1. Remove artificial barriers that are impeding the growth of the industry.
2. The ongoing efforts to "auction" satellite broadcast frequencies/spectrum and TV channel permissions should be avoided.
3. The ongoing practice of "windowing" for the assignment of satellite frequencies by WPC needs to be reformed.
4. Allow VSAT Services to be provided without any restrictions and in any combination across India.
5. De-license the VSAT terminals so that the import/local manufacturing and sale of terminals can be easily done.
6. Expand the scope for existing Service Providers so that they can grow the market and proliferate satellite Broadband access across the SAARC countries.
7. Open the supply of Satellite Capacity.
8. All uplink teleports for broadcast services should be permitted to plan for contingencies such as natural disasters by entering into arrangements with similar facilities located in other jurisdictions and transponders on alternate satellites respectively.
9. Inclusion of Broadcasting Satellite Service (BSS) Plan Frequency bands so as to augment the total satellite capacity available over India.

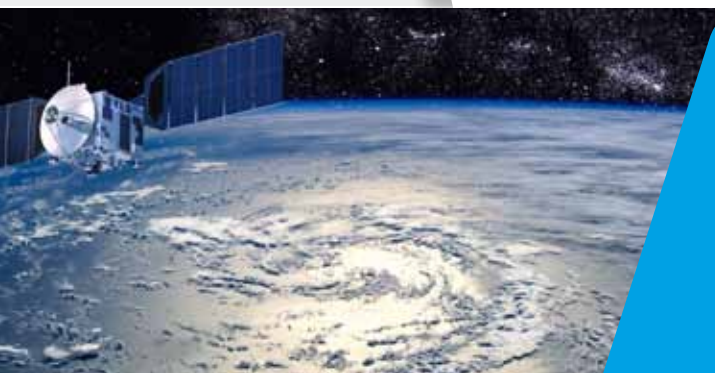
